Sexual Diversity in Science, Technology, Engineering & Math (STEM) Featured Presenter: Jeremy Yoder

As queer academics, Jeremy Yoder, a postdoc in Plant Biology at the University of Minnesota, and Allison Mattheis, an Assistant Professor of Applied & Advanced Studies in Education at California State University Los Angeles, were both interested in understanding and improving the climate for LGBTQ faculty, staff, and students in academic science. In a nationwide survey of more than 1,400 LGBTQ professionals in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (the Queer in STEM study), Mattheis and Yoder asked basic questions to identify who we are, what fields we work in, how our careers compare to those of our straight peers, and how our identities interact with our chosen work.



Health at the Intersection of Race, Gender, Age, and Sexual Orientation Featured Presenter Gilbert Gonzales

LGBT people are often considered—both in policy and research—as a monolithic group, but many LGBT people possess other social identities that may expose them to other forms of structural and interpersonal discrimination, such as racism, sexism and ageism. For the first time in its 56-year history, a question regarding sexual orientation was added to the U.S. National Health Interview Survey, the principal source of information on the health of the population in the United States. This presentation by Gilbert Gonzales (UMN School of Public Health) uses new health data to explore disparities in health and access to care at the intersections of sexual orientation, race/ethnicity, gender and age.
